SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

Wallace Grade School provides a hot lunch program that serves nutritious, well-balanced meals to students. The cost of a hot lunch with milk for students is \$2.25 daily. A carton of milk is 30 cents. You will receive a menu each month. A record of your purchases will be kept at school. It is helpful if you put a check or cash in an envelope. Please mark the envelope with the following information:

- 1. Child's name and grade
- 2. Amount of money that is enclosed.

In response to parent requests for online lunch payments, teacherease is now setup to accept online payments for student lunch accounts by following these steps.

1. Log into teacherease

2. Access the lunch balances by clicking the 'Fees' tab on the left side of your child's dashboard. That will take you to a screen showing your balance. At the bottom there will be a tab 'make online payment'.

3. Click on 'make online payment'

4. Enter credit card information. Payment will come to teacherease account through WePay.

WePay charges a transaction fee for each deposit made.

The fee is 2.987% of amount deposited and an additional .31 cents per transaction.

For example, a \$50 deposit will cost parents \$1.80. A \$100 deposit will cost parents \$3.30.

Please note that Wallace does not charge or collect fees for this and this is just an option for parents.

We will continue to accept lunch payments in the office as well.
