Kindergarten Requirements:

- 1. Child must be 5 years of age on or before Sept.1
- 2. A completed Proof of Residency form
- 3. Must have a birth certificate
- 4. Physical exam, including all immunizations are required by the 1st day of school
- Must have a lead screening test and an eye exam
- 6. Dental exam is required by May 15th

There are immunization clinics in the area. If you have any question regarding immunizations, call the LaSalle County Health Department at 433-3366.

Tentative last day of school (1:30 dismissal) will now be Tuesday, May 29.
