



2015-2016 Kindergarten Registration: We will again be offering a phone in registration for your Kindergarten student. Please call Wallace Grade School at 433-2986 beginning **Monday, March 9th.**

Kindergarten Requirements:

- 1. Child must be 5 years of age on or before Sept.1
- 2. Must have a birth certificate
- 3. Physical exam, including all immunizations are required by the 1st day of school
- 4. Must have a lead screening test and an eye exam
- 5. Dental exam is required by May 15th
