### Kindergarten Requirements:

1. Child must be 5 years of age on or before Sept. 1
2. Must have a birth certificate
3. Physical exam, including all immunizations are required by the 1st day of school
4. Must have a lead screening test and an eye exam
5. Dental exam is required by May 15th
