MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE:

We are in the middle of "Flu" season (stomach & respiratory) so we need to be aware that we are taking the right precautions. Here are a few ways to prevent you or family members from getting sick:

Handwashing is the single most important way to prevent the spread of infection. Hands should be washed before you eat, after you go to the restroom, after you cough or sneeze, and it is also a good idea to wash your hands when you come home from work or school.

Stay home from work or school if you have a fever over 100.5 (without the use of a fever reducer), if you have a contagious disease such as strep throat, vomiting, or diarrhea, or if you are feeling not well overall.

Don't do the research for your child. Let your child find the project that he/she wants to complete. Do make certain that your child allows enough time from start to finish. Once again Wallace Grade School is participating in Math-a-Thon, a program for students in grades K–8 that benefits St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. This cancer research center treats the world's sickest children battling cancer and other deadly diseases, regardless of whether their parents are able to pay for their medical care. Most of the daily operating cost of the facility is covered by public contributions.

Math-a-Thon was designed to supplement the math curriculum while teaching our children the importance of helping others. This week students will watch a St. Jude/Math-a-Thon video and bring home Math-a-Thon information. Students who choose to participate should return their permission slips by Friday, January 22. They will then ask family and friends for Math-a-Thon pledges. Participants will receive Funbooks approximately 2 weeks after the permission slips are received. Upon completion of the Funbook activities, students collect donations from their sponsors and return them to school.
