Fall benchmark testing:

We are in the process of finishing the fall benchmark testing of all students.

We utilize Aimsweb, Fountas & Pinnell and current curriculum to assess and monitor students as we work to best meet each of their specific academic needs. Students are identified for interventions based on student assessment data and classroom performance. If students are identified, they will receive additional instruction in reading and/or math. They will work with school personnel to increase reading fluency, comprehension, and/or math skills two to five times per week for 10 to 30 minutes per day. Wallace Grade School District 195


