Note from the School Nurse

September is Head Lice Prevention Month......

Now that we are back to school and in "close quarters", please remember to check your child's hair for nits and/or lice twice a week. Head lice can be spread whenever there is direct contact of the head or hair with an infested individual. Lice can also be spread through the sharing of personal articles like hats, towels, brushes, helmets, hair ties, etc. Lice do not differentiate between a clean head or a dirty head although studies have shown that combing your hair daily is a good preventative way to detect the presence of nits (eggs) or live lice. --Mrs. Matteson

FALL / WINTER WEATHER:

Students should be wearing a light jacket or coat to school. Wallace winds often make the weather much cooler than in town.
