RTI: AimsWeb benchmark testing:

We are in the process of finishing the fall Aimsweb testing of all students. We utilize our Aimsweb system to track (progress monitor) students as we work to best meet each of their specific academic needs. Students are identified based on Aimsweb student assessment data and classroom performance. Once students are identified, they will receive additional instruction in reading and/or math. They will work with school personnel to increase reading fluency, comprehension, and/or math skills two to five times per week for 10 to 30 minutes per day. If your child is identified, we will send a letter home further explaining the RTI (Response to Intervention) process.
