If you have not registered your Kindergarten student yet, please call Wallace Grade School at 433-2986

Kindergarten Requirements:

- 1. Child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1st
- 2. Must have a birth certificate
- 3. Physical exam, including all immunizations are required by the 1st day of school
- 4. Must have a lead screening test and an eye exam
- 5. Dental exam is required by May 15th

There are immunization clinics in the area. If you have any question regarding immunizations, call the LaSalle County Health Department at 433-3366.

Please note that lunch balances must be paid in full prior to the end of the year. 
